“Additional parameters of clarity: A minimum of 40% of the total grant amount must be awarded to the HARA and funding to the HARA cannot be reduced from last year’s level. In addition, if the CoC/LPB receives an increased allocation, funding to the HARA must increase equal to or higher than the highest percent increase provided to a subgrantee.”
