It's HUD CoC Program Competition time! Please note it is an extremely tight turn around. CoCs expressed their concerns to HUD SNAPS office, and they understand our frustration with the tight turn around however it cannot be changed. To that end, we do empathize with you on how quick we have to respond. The FY2022 CoC Program Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) opened August 1, 2022. HUD facilitated a NOFO office hours on Thursday, August 11, 2022. Applications are due to HUD Friday, September 30, 2022, by 8:00 PM EST. Click [here](#) to see the full announcement.

Metro Community Development (MCD) is the Flint/Genesee County CoC Collaborative Applicant; therefore, MCD is responsible for overseeing the application process for CoC Program fund submission. Prospective applicants are encouraged to review these materials carefully and note 1) the **Letter of Intent** to apply is due **August 22, 2022, by 11:59 PM**, and 2) **project applications** are due to Metro Community Development, **Monday, August 29, 2022 by 11:59 PM**. For the detailed FY2022 NOFO [local competition timelines](#) see attached. **PLEASE NOTE: on Wednesday, August 31, 2022, 9:00AM – 12:00 PM**, there will be a special prioritization meeting (this is the meeting the CoC votes to approve, reduce or reject the projects).

Please see the attached FY2022 Flint/Genesee County CoC RFP (request for applications) public announcement. *Please make sure to read the RFP document and the attachments thoroughly.* Also attached is the copy of the CoC Narrative Application.

The amount of Tier 1 funding estimated to be available from HUD is **\$2,269,459**. This is less than the current ARD of **\$2,388,904** for all projects not including CoC Planning. In addition Tier 2, **\$239,996** is available for the Continuum of Care Bonus and **\$479,992** is available for Domestic Violence Projects. Please see attached the FY2021 rating factors, FY2021 example of the Report Card based on rating factors. If you have any questions or concerns regarding this funding NOFO allocation notice, please feel free to contact me.
