

2021 POINT-IN-TIME COUNT RESULTS



POINT-IN-TIME AMIDST COVID-19

COVID-19 responsiveness informed this year's count:

- increasing the use of outreach teams in street-based counts
- reducing the reliance on volunteers to conduct the PIT
- increasing the use of technology in training and surveying
- combining observation-based and survey approaches across nights and populations
- reducing the overall burden by creating statistically valid samples

As a result, we conducted our most comprehensive Point-in-Time count to date, despite the significant challenges of COVID-19.



2021 POINT-IN-TIME KEY FINDINGS

↓ **4% overall reduction** in people experiencing homelessness

↑ 5% sheltered increase

↓ 36% unsheltered decrease

special populations:

- 18 unaccompanied veterans
- 19 unaccompanied youth +
- 6 parenting youth 18-24 with 11 children

Key contributors:

- Strong weekly HMIS reporting pre-count to inform street outreach
- Outreach Grid app incorporating not yet HMIS-participating agencies
- Rapid re-housing resources through ESG-CV
- Hotel and motel support
- Comprehensive unduplication efforts

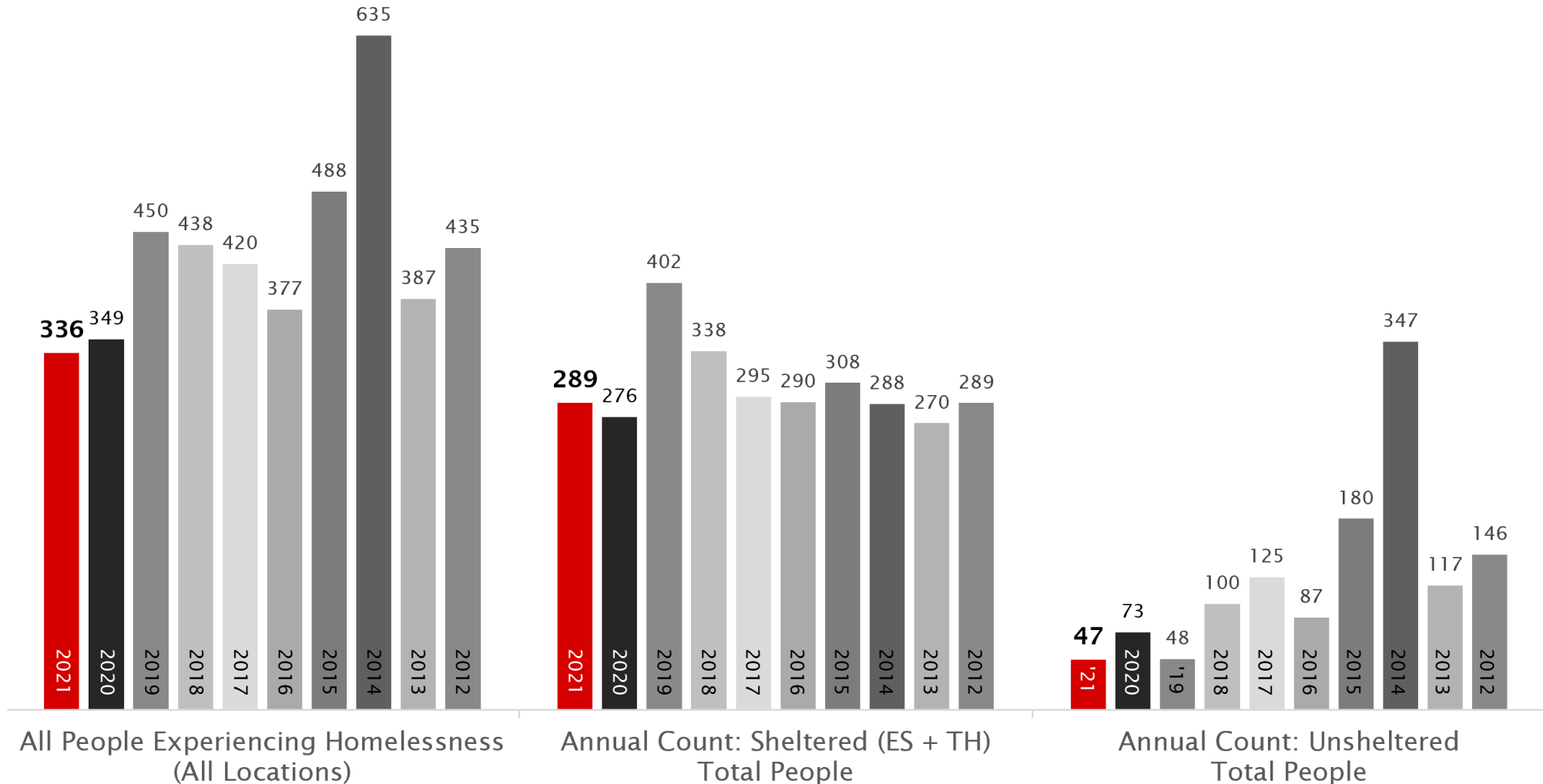

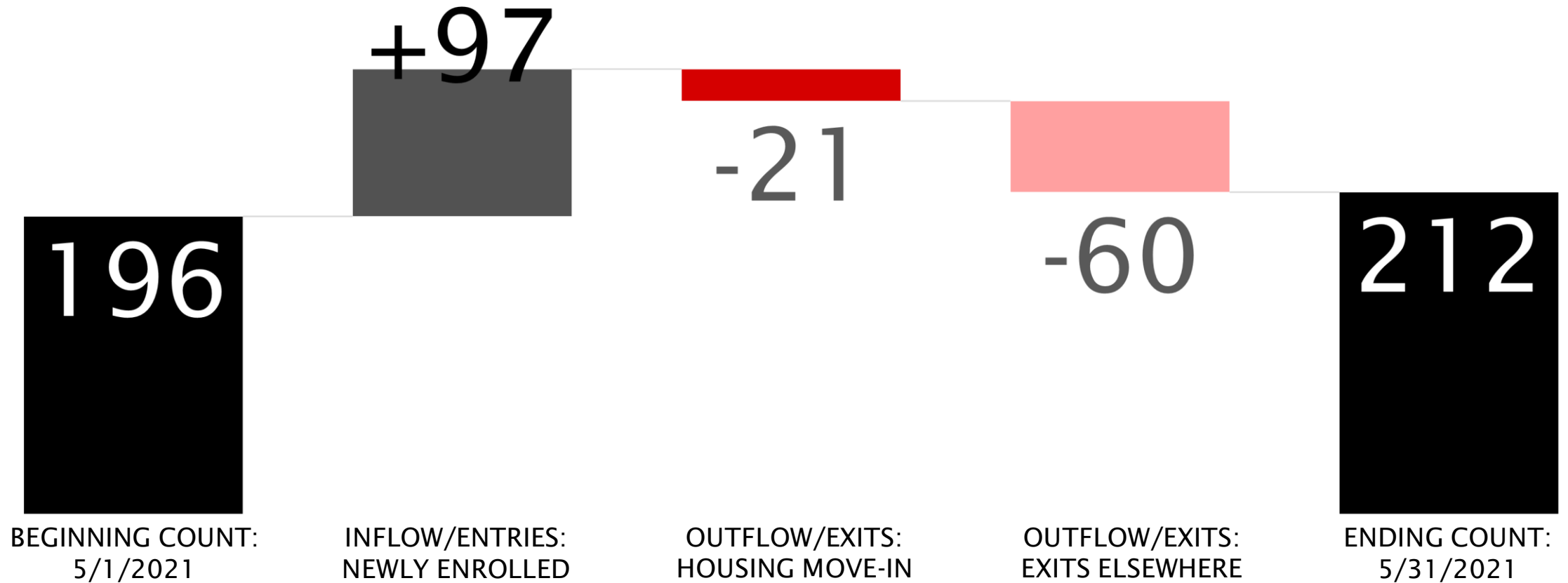

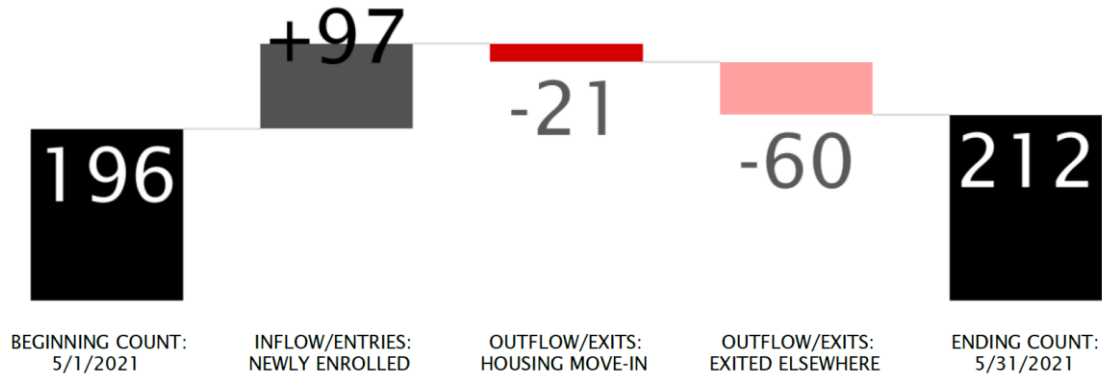

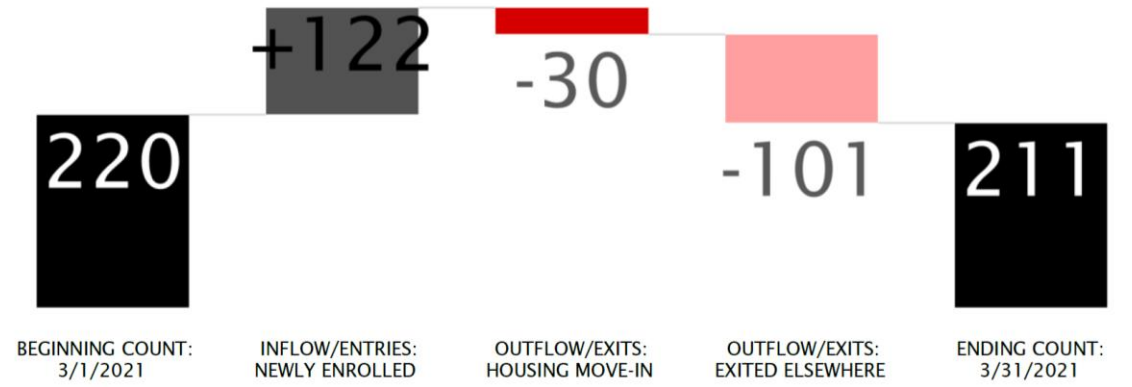
MAY 2021 HMIS-REPORTED HOMELESSNESS INFLOW AND OUTFLOW



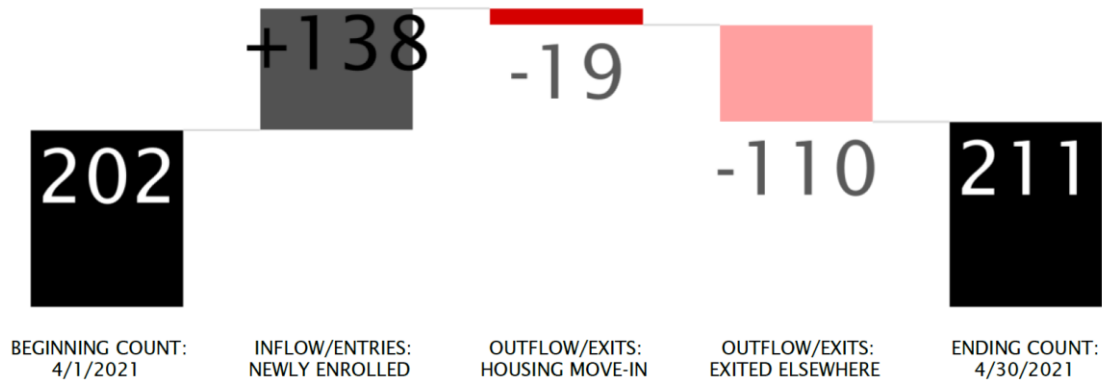
MAY 2021 HMIS-REPORTED HOMELESSNESS INFLOW AND OUTFLOW



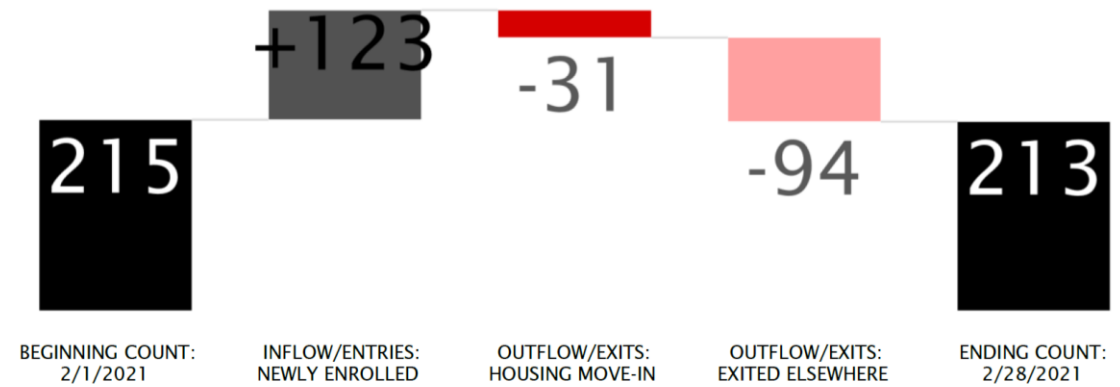
MARCH 2021 HMIS-REPORTED HOMELESSNESS INFLOW AND OUTFLOW
